Use the part whole method to add and subtract. Make and find number bonds to 10. Understand related addition and subtraction facts. Solve word problems.

As Scientists can we?

Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made?
Describe materials using their senses?
Describe materials using their senses, using specific scientific words?
Explain what material objects are made from and why it might be useful for a specific job.
Name some different everyday materials.
Sort materials into groups by a given criteria
Explain how solid shapes can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching?

As Readers can we...?

Use phonic knowledge to decode books accurately that have the phoneme / grapheme correspondences in that I know.
Show awareness of a range of punctuation marks. Become familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales and I can retell them.

As Writers can we...?

Use adjectives to describe a character.
Retell and write the story of the three little pigs using story maps and short sentences.
Change parts of the story to make a new story.
Create and write a short narrative. Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

In ICT can we...?

Explore the purple mash programme using grouping and sorting apps. Make pictograms using 2count and 2connect apps.

In art can we?

Celebrate Diwali by making Diwali cards. Use a simple painting program to create a picture?
Study artists Beatriz Milhazes to look at abstract art, Bridget Riley to look at drawings exploring line and David Hockney to look at art inspired by water.
Explore art through the use of colour.

In PSHE can we...?

Accept that everyone is different. Include others. Understand what bullying is and what to do. How to make and receive compliments.

In RE can we...?

Begin to learn about the Hindu faith. Celebrate Diwali and learn about Christmas.

Play instruments with a song.
